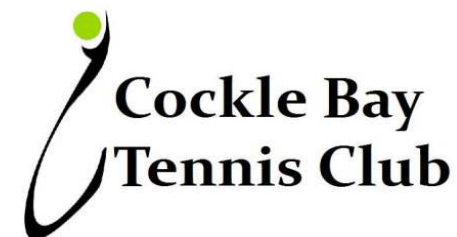

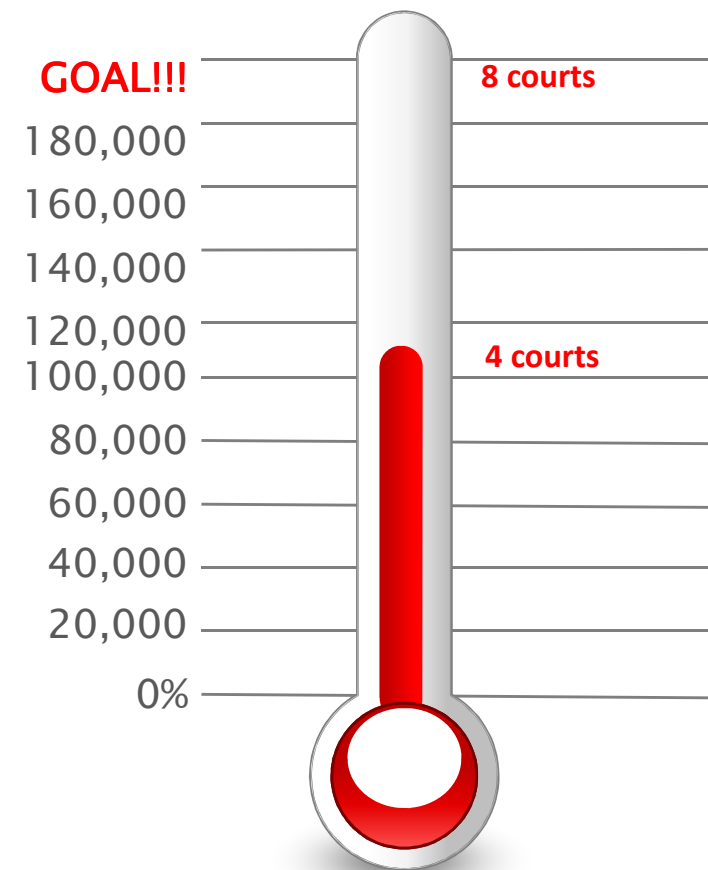
# Court Resurfacing Update

So far the club has raised \$107,000 towards the \$180,000 target to replace all 8 courts. This has been a result of the many hours Brian Craig has put into applying for funding over the last 12 months. Huge thanks to Brian for his tireless efforts to date.

We are currently obtaining quotes from interested parties and plan to start resurfacing the courts over the Xmas/January period. At this stage the club hopes to have enough funding to commence with 4 courts and should we receive enough funding by the time work gets started, we will resurface more.

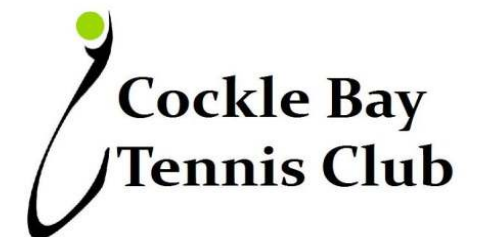

# AGM Update



On the 28<sup>th</sup> June the club held their Annual General Meeting.

**Committee Update** - After 3 years in the role of President, **Brian Craig** is stepping down from the position. Brian has been a member of the club since 1988, a former Club Captain, and since 2009 become the club's special projects co-ordinator which resulted in him spending hundreds of hours on funding applications enabling the club to attain additional tennis courts, a new modern facility, security cameras, junior coaching grants, outdoor furniture, floodlight repairs, to name but a few. Brian also played an intricate part in the approach when Macleans was disbanding. He was also a member of the building sub committee entrusted with the responsibility of building and funding the clubroom upper level. Brian has also been invaluable in securing sponsorship for our club, and a valuable member on both the Tennis/Squash Partnership Committee and Meadowlands Multi Sport Committee. Brian has very kindly agreed to stay in the role of Funding & Sponsorship Co-ordinator and has been instrumental in attaining over \$100,000 in funding to date for the club's court resurfacing project.

After 15 consecutive years in the Coaching/ Building Maintenance, Committee, Senior/ Junior Interclub selection and MMSC Director roles, **Mike Frankle** advised his resignation from the committee at the AGM, but has indicated a willingness to take up position(s) in the Club's organisation in a non-committee capacity, continuing on as MMSC Director. Mike's contribution in the above positions has been immeasurable and the Club has benefited from his promotion of junior tennis in the local schools/ community bolstering junior membership numbers, the building of the MMSC facility following his liaison with Council/contractors and onsite project management and his maintenance work around our facility and courts.

The club would like to sincerely thank both Brian and Mike for their dedication to the club over the many years. Their experience and commitment to the club has simply been invaluable and the club would not be where it is today without members like Brian and Mike.

We would like to welcome Vicki Ashley in the role of President, Megan Burrows as Vice President, and new committee members Mike Herrick, Neil Prime and Mike Atwill.

Our club has been very fortunate to have dedicated and knowledgeable committee members giving freely of their precious time for the betterment of our tennis club and its members. As outlined at the AGM our club operated with a staggering 64 Committee, MMSC Director, HSC/ CBTC Partnership, Sub Committee, Delegate and Working/Project Sub Committee roles during the past year. The club strongly encourages members to assist some of their time to get on board with helping at the club as too few members are doing far too much and would help take some of the pressure off the incoming committee. Please contact the committee if you are able to help in some way as there are a number of non-committee positions available.

**Subscriptions** - Subscriptions were increased by 8% for the 2015-16 season. This is reflected by there being no increase in subscriptions for the 2014-15 season. The increase does include ball money and Tennis Auckland/NZ levies. Research has been carried out and these new levels remain comparable with other tennis clubs in the area.

**Annual Court Maintenance Levy** - This season the club has also had the need to introduce an annual Court Maintenance Levy. As was pointed out at the recent AGM the club has been told by our previous auditor about the high dependency the club has on funding. The club is currently seeking \$180,000 to uplift and resurface 8 courts. Looking ahead when this has to be done again in 8-10 years it will be in the region of \$180-200,000. The club also faces greater difficulty now in getting funding. The club also has concerns as to where the funding where will go in future years.

As a result it was passed at the AGM a Court Maintenance Levy of \$25 (incl GST) be introduced per member. This will be banked and invested separately and set aside for court maintenance work in the future. The club is dependent on having good courts and does not want to be in a position where we may have to get a loan or a total dependency on funding to re-surface our courts. The Committee will also be negotiating a fee for non-members receiving coaching at our facility to also contribute to this levy.

The club understands these increases may have an impact on some members. As a result the club is now offering members the opportunity to pay their membership off by direct debit authority over the course of the membership season. Please contact the club office for documentation to be sent to you if you wish to take up this option.

# Juniors & Intermediates



We are very fortunate to have an excellent Junior Tennis Programme at our club.

## Club Nights

Junior Club Night will continue to run over two nights. Starting in Term 4 (15<sup>th</sup> October), Thursday Club Night will be for junior players at Primary School and Friday Club Night for Intermediate and College players. The focus will be social, organised match play with a coach available to give tactical advice.

Club Nights will run weekly from 4.30 to 6.30pm during Term 4 2015 and Term 1 2016. We will continue to hold food nights when players will be asked to bring \$5 for food. Once again we will be asking for parents to volunteer their services to help with food preparation/collection. If you can help please tick this under the Volunteer Section on the 2014-15 enrolment form.

## Coaching

The club follows a pathway which is outlined under the Coaching page in this newsletter.

### Hot Shots

Players who are new to the game start with Hot Shots Coaching. The club holds 2 sessions on Saturday morning during Term 4 and Term 1.

#### 9 to 10am

**Red Stage** using Red (25% compression) balls (Ages 5 to 8)

**Orange Stage** using Orange (50% compression) balls (Ages 8 to 10).

#### 10-11am

**Green Stage** using Green (75% compression) balls (Ages 9 and above)

## Junior Coaching

This progressive tennis coaching programme has been developed for juniors of intermediate age, often once they have completed Hot Shots. All aspects of the game are covered in a fun and engaging way including scoring, tactical and technical skills.

These are 8 week courses (1 hour coaching session per week) held after school during all four school terms.

*Tournaments = Interclub and Contender*

## Wilson Tennis Academy

For those players who are ready to formally compete, players can then opt to attend the Wilson Tennis Academy. This is broken into 3 levels:

Tier 1 – Elite

Tier 2 – Performance

Tier 3 – Development

*Tournaments = Regional, National and Interclub*

## Junior Interclub

Interclub is tennis matches between different teams from clubs with affiliation to Tennis Auckland. Each year there are 2 competitions run:

Pre Xmas competition (runs during Term 4 of the school year)

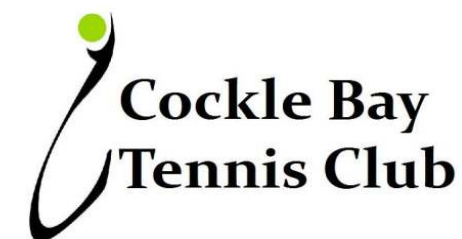
Post Xmas competition (runs during Term 1 of the school year)

There are Beginner Grades (for those who have never played interclub before) and the Open Age Group Grades. Interclub is played on a Saturday or Sunday morning. Juniors find interclub a lot of fun and it certainly develops their game. The majority of our Juniors move onto Junior Interclub after mastering the basic skills obtained through Junior Coaching. The club enters junior teams according to the level of interest and ability shown by juniors. We try and ensure that grades entered are of a similar ability so matches are even. Participating in Junior Interclub competition will substantially develop your tennis skills and provides an ideal environment to apply some of the skills being learnt in the coaching programme. We do not force juniors to play if they are not interested. If Interclub is not for them, our club day is also a great way to develop tennis skills. We will notify you by email when entries are open.
